Shall bonds be issued by the Board of Education of the Blanchester Local School District for the purpose of constructing and reconstructing school buildings and furnishing and equipping the same including development of site, in the sum of eight hundred and four thousand dollars (\$804,000) and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten mill limitation, estimated by the County Auditor, to amount to 3.80 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirty eight (38) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a maximum period of 23 years. And shall pay the principal and interest of such bonds. And shall an additional levy of taxes for the benefit of the Blanchester Local School District for the purpose of paying the cost of the purchase of classroom facilities from Slater, at the rate of one half mill for each one dollar of valuation, except that in those years in which the tax rate for debt service outside the ten mill limitation is less than three and one half mills, the rate shall be increased to that rate which is the difference between four mills and the tax rate for debt service, outside the ten mills limitation, until the purchase price is paid, but in no case longer than twenty-three (23) years?
