We, the undersigned, Board of Elections of said County, do hereby certify that the

Special Election held in Lebanon City School District
(Primary, General or Special) (Name of Subdivision)

in said County, on the 31st day of March, 1976, on the question:

"Shall bonds be issued by the Board of Education of the Lebanon City School District
for the purpose of improving and renovating the Dorsey Middle School also known as the old High School and to provide equipment, furnishings & site improvement

in the sum of two million three hundred thousand dollars (\$2,300,000)

and a levy of taxes be made outside of the ten mill limitation estimated by the County Auditor to average 3.2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirty two cents (\$0.32) for each one hundred dollars

of valuation, for a maximum period of twelve (12) years to pay the principal and interest of such bonds", resulted as follows:
