An additional tax for the benefit of the Little Miami Local School District, Counties of Warren and Clermont, Ohio for the purpose of CONSTRUCTING IMPROVEMENTS TO SCHOOL FACILITIES AND PROVIDING EQUIPMENT, FURNISHINGS AND SITE IMPROVEMENTS THEREFOR at a rate not exceeding one and eighty-five hundredths (1.85) mills for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to eighteen and five tenths cents (\$.185) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing with the tax year 1984.
